All officers have been trained in the operation, use, and policies governing these systems.

Privacy & Policy Highlights

- Officers must record incidents within the scope of their official duties.
- Routine, non-enforcement, or community caretaking activities do not require recording.
- Officers will notify and seek consent when recording certain events.

Ahead of Schedule

- Since summer, full-time officers have been field-testing the new systems. Full deployment is on track and ahead of the January 1, 2025 deadline.



NEW TECHNOLOGY FOR ENHANCED PUBLIC SAFETY

The Kenilworth Police Department is upgrading its technology with the Axon Body-Worn Camera (BWC) System and Axon Fleet 3 In-Car Cameras. This new equipment will:

- Enhance public safety
- Maintain transparency
- Build trust within the community

Why the Upgrade?

The SAFE-T Act requires all police departments serving municipalities under 50,000 residents to implement BWCs by January 1, 2025.
